We Taste: grapefruit, pine, mango, creamsicle

We Taste: apricot, peach rings, bright citrus, hint of pine

Let's take Nugget and double it. To start, we boosted the Simcoe, and this complex hop's notes of apricot, peach rings and bright citrus are the star of the show. Azacca adds hints of juicy orchard fruit, and Munich malt brings a bready sweetness. Columbus joins Nugget hops, grounding this limited release with a layer of dank pine.
